3	Amy	Very large flower in purple blue with white throat and dar purple veins.	S	
4	Anna Maria	Pastel lilac pink flowers with yellow throat. Can flower for 10 months.	S	
5	Annabel	White flowers with pastel pink veins on the lower lobes.	S	
6	Anne	Deepest purple, fully double. Very beautiful and distinctive	D	
7	Awena	Creamy white flowers with shocking pink veins blending into a large yellow throat. Very free flowering on short stalks	S	
8	Bethan	Sky blue upper lobes, lower lobes having a tracery of purple overlying the blue. Masses of tightly clustered flowers	S	
9	Black Gardenia	A short plant with fully double plum purple flowers	D	
10	Black Knight	Very dark black purple flower with small yellow throat.	S	
11	Black Panther	A variety with the most deep purple flowers imaginable. Two thin yellow bars emerge from the centre of the throat	S	
12	Blue Wonder	Very blue flowers with a yellow throat.	S	
13	Blushing Bride	White flowers with just a hint of pink. Compact variety with semidouble flowers	SD	
14	Bristol's Agitaded Eel	Large white blooms thoroughly veined purple, edged white. Very vigorous, fast grower and constant bloomer.	S	
15	Bristol's Blue Blopper	Big, very blue-blue, velvety blooms. Heavy bloomer, very big and very blue!	S	
16	Bristol's Cat Dance	Very striking. Dark blue lower petals, widely edged white, white upper petals, tipped blue. Extremely profuse bloomer, always covered with masses of flowers. Easy grower.	S	
17	Bristol's Daisy Doodle	Very striking! Large, almost pointed, petals on deep red-purple blooms with wide white borders. Compact, flat, foliage that shapes well. Excellent grower and bloomer. .	S

45	Cynthia	Glowing magenta red flowers. Short flower stalks. Excellent variety.	S	
46	Daphne	Very free flowering variety with large pastel blue flowers. The face of the flower has two yellow flashes in the centre. Fairly compact with a neat habit.	S	
47	Delphine	Dark velvety purple with white throat. Gives masses of small flowers.	S	
48	Diana	Deep cerise with white throat. Nice colour!	S	
49	Donna	Purple red flowers with darker veins on the lower lobes	S	
50	Elisabeth	White flowers with dark purple veins on the lower lobes. Stunning!	S	
51	Ellie	Vibrant velvety cherry pink flowers with a soft blush pink on upper lobes. Unusual reflexed lobes are very reminiscent of a Sweet Pea or Orchid.	S	
52	Elsi	A spectacular colour; large flowers of the deepest purple with two small yellow flashes at the centre	S	
53	Emily	Pale pink-lilac edges and a large yellow eye, very attractive variety.	S	
54	Emma	Free flowering variety with phlox pink lobes and ruby red pencilling on its lower three lobes	S	
55	Falling Stars	Produces masses of small dainty sky blue flowers. Very spectacular, early flowering and easy to grow.	S	
56	Fiona	Pink with wavy edged petals.	S	
57	Fluffy Frills (Silvia)	Frilly flowers, purple on the upper lobes, yellow on the lower lobes. Gives masses of flowers. One of our best sellers!	S	
58	Frosty Diamond	Mid blue flowers covered in inky blue veins. Tidy habit and produces masses of flowers.	S	
59	Greta Garbo	Very large flowers in purple red. Hugh flowers!	S	
60	Gwen	White flowers with soft blue veins on the lower lobes. Magnificent!	S	
61	Hannah	The flowers are pale pink when they are first open, darkening to a mid pink after a couple of days. The throat is a strong yellow which extends over the lower lobes, overlaid with 7 short purple lines. The habit is very similar to its sister plant 'Hope'.	S	
62	Happy Snappy	Neat flowers in a deep magenta with a carmine throat and yellow flashes. A small plant, quite distinct and different from any other red Streptocarpus.	S	
63	Havannah	Purple red flowers with two white stripes on the lower lobes	S	
64	Heavenly	White flower base with purple blue veins. Stunning!!!	S	
65	Heidi	A lovely clear blue with distinctive deep purple markings on the lower lobes. A beauty!	S	
66	Helena	Purple blue flowers with purple throat and two white stripes on the lower lobes.	S	
67	Hope	The flowers are a rich velvety red/purple with two strong yellow flashes in the throat. A medium/compact variety which is very free flowering for over 10 months of the year. The leaves are mid-green and reasonably compact.	S	
68	Iced Pink Flamingo	A <i>spectacular</i> plant with very bright, almost glowing, large pink blooms over <i>variegated</i> green and white foliage. A large, very showy, plant.	S

69	Iona	A pretty violet-purple flower wich fades to orange-red in the throat. Narrow leaves with an upright habit. Special colour!	S	
70	Jacque	Large clusters of soft pale blue flowers with deeper mid blue veining on short stems above a rosette of medium sized leaves. A very prolific bloomer.	S	
71	Jessica	A rose pink variety with flowers which are flat faced and slightly upturned. An early flowering variety wich will keep flowering for 10 months. Short flower stems.	S	
72	Karen	Magenta pink with lower petals darker coloured and veined.	S	
73	Katie	A strong variety which is very free flowering with deep inky purple veins on a paler background. Very distinctively marked flowers with about 8 flowers per stem.	S	
74	Kim	A very compact plant, blooming early, with a multiflowering head of small deep inky blue flowers.	S	
75	Laura	Pale pink with distinct deep pink veins on the lower three lobes. A multi flowering variety. Very nice!	S	
76	Leyla	A large flowering variety, white with very strong purple blue veining on the lower 3 lobes. Overall the plant has a medium/compact habit with mid green leaves. Flowers continuously for 10 months.	S	
77	Lily	Large flower in blue purple with white throat and dark purple stripes.	S	
78	Lisa	Salmon pink flowers, with darker salmon veins.	S	
79	Louise	Pink flowers with rose on the lower lobes en two pink stripes.	S	
80	Megan	A medium sized plant with long elegant flower stems held nicely upright. Flowers are a violet purple with a very distinctive streak of yellow in the centre.	S	
81	Midnight Flame	Very deep red flowers; rich and velvety in appearance. Mid green foliage	S	
82	Nerys	A stunning combination of colours! The upper lobes of the flower petals are edged pale blue with a splash of cream in the middle. The lower 3 lobes have purple veining with a hint of copper in the throat around two yellow stripes. An exceptionally free flowering plant with a neat habbit.	S	
83	Nia	The flowers appear pale pink with a yellow eye but the pink gradually gets darker around the edge. This gives an attractive picotee edge and a mixture of colour tones on the head of the flowers	S	
84	Olwen	Very deep inky purple flowers with slightly serrated edges make this a stunning variety. The colour of the bloom is very intense with a rich velvet sheen. Medium sized flowers on a fairly compact plant.	S	
85	Padarn	A vibrant pink with flat faced flowers. Very free flowering on tall stems. Early and long flowering variety, up to 10 months a year.	S	
86	Party Doll	A compact variety. Flowers are quite different from any other variety in that the colour is a mixture of pastel pinks and blue. The colour varies between the two shades.	S	
87	Pink Leyla	Very similar in habit to 'Leyla' but with very strong rose pink markings. A beauty!	S	
88	Pink Souffle	A very frilly pink double variety. A prolific bloomer and very unusual.	D	
89	Princesse	A lovely glowing deep pink with dark veining.	S	
90	Rebecca	A strong variety. Pale lavender flowers with deep purple veining over the lower face, upturned and open flowers.	S

91	Rhiannon	Each flower stalk carries a large number of white bell shaped flowers that have a yellow centre with purple stripes. Grows to a large size.	S	
92	Rosebud	The first fully double streptocarpus. Large deep pink ruffled flowers with a cluster of extra petals in the centre. A strong grower.	D	
93	Roulette Azur	Amazing colour pattern with azur blue border around a sharp with centre. Compact stems on a medium sized plant. Stunning!!!	S	
94	Roulette Cherry	Amzaing colour pattern with scarlet red border around a sharp with centre. Compact stems on a medium sized plant. Very stunning!!!	S	
95	Ruby	Beautiful rich red flowers, freely borne, forming a nice head on a medium sized plant.	S	
96	Salmon Sunset	A wonderful shade of salmon-coral, with dark veins on yellow throat. Excellent bloomer and grower. A unique color.	S	
97	Sandra	The flowers have an unusual and attractive coulour pattern. They are large, mauve with a tracery of deep violet veining on the lower lobes, leading into a yellow throat.	S	
98	Sarah	Pink on the upper lobes, pink rose on the lower lobes.	S	
99	Seren	This is a new colour break. A strong yellow background with inky blue veins and violet blue edging. A plant of compact habit which flowers freely for 10 months. Superb!	S	
100	Sian	The flowers are wistaria blue with a strong yellow eye and thin blue lines emanating from the throat. The flowers are held on short stalks froming a nicely proportioned plant.	S	
101	Sky Blue	Sky blue flowers with dark purple stripes on the lower lobes and a yellow throat. One of our best sellers!	S	
102	Snow White	Pure white flowers with a yellow throat and two yellow marks on the lower lobes. Excellent bloomer!	S	
103	Snowflake	Pure white flowers with purple red veins.	S	
104	Sophie	Multi-flowering variety with deep plum pink flowers with an iridescent velvet sheen on the lower lobes. Very attractively shaped plant.	S	
105	Soraya	Pink flowers with rose pink veins on the lower lobes	S	
106	Southshore	Large plum red flowers on tall stems. A free flowering plant that makes a wonderful specimen.	S	
107	Stella	Flowers are pink with plum red veining.	S	
108	Stephanie	A very attractive patterned flower, lilac background with deep purple veining over all the petals. Small flowers and incredibly free flowering. This plant starts to flower very early and will carry on for a very long period.	S	
109	Susan	A well rounded plant of short habit. Many intense magenta flowers with golden yellow centres produced on each stalk. Very spectacular!	S	
110	Texas Hot Chili	This is a compact variety with unusual deep red flowers with a yellow eye. Small flat faced flowers.	S	
111	Tina	Upper lobes pale pink, lower lobes bright magenta, with distinct veins. A compact free flowering plant.	S	
112	Tracey	Dainty deep magenta flowers. Multiflowering head. Medium sized variety.	S	
113	Watermelon Wine	A rose pink variety with deeper red markings on the lower lobes. A strong variety.	S
